Grade 8 Graduation Speech

You have already received an excellent foundation on which to build. I know for some of you your journey so far may not always have been easy, but you have persevered and you been successful so far.

Every one of you in this room has the potential to achieve and to be as successful as you want to be. There is absolutely no reason and no obstacle that you cannot overcome to make sure that you finish high school and to go on to additional education for as long as you wish.

On your journey you will find others who will continue to reach out to you to help you, guide you and support you to get even further on your journey. Make sure you enlist the right friends. Know the difference between true friends and false friends. True friends will be there for you to encourage you to help you to be successful. False friends are those who want to drag you down to their level so that you will not be successful. They are the ones that are not doing well at school themselves and are always in trouble with their parents, their teachers, or the law.

True friends can also be family members and your teachers, they have supported and encouraged you so far and will continue to be there for you when you need them.

I hope that in your own way and on your own time you will take a moment to express your appreciation to your true friends with a simple thank you. You can repay their gift to you by you in turn helping others who may need your help to be successful.

So as you move forward, there is a world of possibilities awaiting you. I am hopeful that each and every one of you will build on what you have accomplished so far to continue your journey to a successful future for yourself. Our society will be a better place because you have gone this far. You are our future. When you are successful, your families will be successful, our community will be successful and our Province & Country will be successful. You have great potential and you can be as successful as you want to be.

Continue to give it all your best and if there should be occasions when times get tough look for and listen to your true friends. They will be there to help you through.
